For the field of musical arts, it is very important to study and practice performing skills and practice, especially for majors in Vocal or Instrumental performance. With style, performance skills, and lots of practice, they will master the performance process, and realize the goals, requirements, and quality of the performance. Light music style

2.1. Light music style concept

Through research, we temporarily understand that: "Light music is a genre of contemporary music (contemporary music) that is easy to listen to, easy to remember, and accessible to bring comfort to listeners... Light music is usually Written in genres: Pop Ballad, Slow, Boston, Valse, Cha cha cha, Bossanova, Dance...

In the world, in some countries with developed music industries, leading music experts have defined contemporary music as follows:

Contemporary music means the variety of things and phenomena affecting the diversity of people. To organize a range of knowledge into a musical strategy sketch. Contemporary Australian music is defined as the composition, recording, and performance of people. Which includes unlimited genres such as Rock, Pop, Hippop, Jazz, Electronic music, Dance music, Country, Folk or erotic, and experimental music (Definition of the Institute for Strategic Research and Development). Australian Federal Government Contemporary Music 2010).

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Berklee Academy of Music in Boston, USA is currently the most prestigious and famous school in the world for training in contemporary music. There are opinions expressed about Contemporary Music

Sean McMahon - Chairman of the Film Scoring Department at Berklee Academy: "Contemporary music is the result of the intersection of composition and technology. Therefore, technology changes very quickly so do composition and contemporary music. Although the Learning program relies heavily on technology, we do not teach technology software. We teach principles because principles do not change. And if students understand the principles, they will be able to adapt to new technological tools. To survive in the profession requires lifelong learning."

The requirement to become a light music singer requires a convergence of many factors, not only having musical qualities but also needing to practice vocal technical ability, performance ability, and musical expression.... Vocal music classification is an extremely important first job for a later vocal training process. Teachers need to carefully learn when playing music and vocal types to come up with appropriate teaching methods. Based on the characteristics of the voice types to make music. Combining elements such as costumes, sound, light, and musical arrangement... are indispensable elements for the successful performance of a light music song. Because a piece of light music that is fully perceived by the public must be really "satisfying" in both content and form. With style, performance skills, and lots of practice, they will master the performance process, and realize the goals, requirements, and quality of the performance. 
2.2. Developing students' ability to sing soft music style Music classification by vocal type

In these types of sopranos, music shows more specific cases such as dramatic soprano, colorful lyrical soprano, and colorful dramatic soprano.




The vocal range is usually from notes c1 to c3

Mezzo: is an intermediate voice between soprano and mezzo-soprano. The soprano voice is also divided into soprano, soprano, and soprano.

The vocal range of the voice is usually from a to a2, there are cases of singing up to b2, but it is very rare.

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When new Vocal students enter the school, many cases have not yet developed their voices, so some teachers have misjudged Soprano's voice to Mezzo's voice, but in the process of learning, many students have developed their voices. higher, so the voice must be redefined. On the other hand, due to the development requirements of society, many children tend to follow light music and sing with real voices, so they are easily mistaken for a Mezzo voice or Alto's voice. Of course, the color factor of the voice always holds the most important position in determining the voice.

2.3. Measures for self-training works - thinking of singing light music in vocal students

Through the experience gathered from the musical composition in the learning process as well as the teaching observation from the lecturers, we have drawn the steps to self-practice in vocal compositions as follows:

Step 1: Practice rhythm

It is important to learn the notes and rhythms of the songs first. Take the time to read the whole thing rhythmically, or clap your hands... to the beat. Use a metronome to keep the beat steady and don't skip this step just because you already know the songs on tape. Recording artists are comfortable with notes and rhythms. It is necessary to know the original notes and rhythms to see the author's ideas and thereby find your style. From once-famous songs, singers made songs bearing their names and transformed them into songs that live forever with time and until now are still loved by the audience with remixes. the ingenuity of young musicians, mixed with a singing style that varies from genre of music to cover variations, mashups... however, in some styles we can act freely with tempo, but some styles otherwise, that freedom is not appropriate...

Step 2: Practice the melody

After reading the rhythm, play the melody on the piano. Learn to form melodies and replay complex intervals, without needing to keep the tempo. Is this tune in my voice range? Can you sing the whole song without stress?

If you feel the song is too high or too low, try singing in different tones. Once the stone has been decided, the voice needs to be rewritten according to that tone.

Identify where breathing is required and mark (') in the track. This basic work will save time in the long run if you mark up well, you won't have trouble breathing in the middle of a word or gasping at the end of a sentence.

Step 3: Practice the technique of voice shifting

Vocal shifting is a relatively difficult technique for students, and practicing to shift pitch is a long and regular job. Practicing the first register can help improve the quality of mid and low voices by increasing flexibility and creating a feeling of freedom when singing high notes.

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The middle voice when singing is mainly singing with the real voice, and when we hit the high note, we use the mixed voice. Blending is a method of coordinating muscular action during singing that is used to blur clarity between different vocal ranges for seamless vocal transitions. First, let's gently switch from one note to another when the voice drops to soften and become smoother, repeat many times to form a habit.

According to Anne Peckham's point of view in the book How to train your voice to become a singer, she gave 6 ways to apply when changing the pitch as follows:

- Use the first voice even if the transition is not smooth. Smooth transitions are only achieved with practice... Enhancing and strengthening your head voice helps you achieve more tonality and greater range.

- Exercises with descending pitches can help blur the boundaries between vocal ranges. Makes transitioning to low tones easy.

- Practicing the first vocal range can increase flexibility and create a feeling of not being afraid when singing high notes.

Surfing exercises can help relax the larynx, making it easier to change vocals.

- High notes: must be soft and precise to a high standard. Catch your voice at least one note higher than your public performance.

Step 4: Feel and understand the music.

Guide and let students listen, watch classical music works of famous singers in light music style and give comments as it helps us to have our concept of the song. Imitating singers' voices is not advisable. However, we can learn a lot from a song by watching the punctuation, tempo, emotion, tempo, and meaning. How did the singer in the song describe the melody, rhythm, and harmony? Is the tone of the recording higher or lower than the tone you are singing? Record the singer's voice. Do you like that voice? Is the singer's rhythmic feeling or harmonizing style the same as I imagined? How do you like it? What is the genre of the song? Answering these questions will give you a concept of your own.

Step 5: Thinking about processing works

The expression means adding one's expressions to the song. It could be the way the lyrics are presented, the personal style, the change of the melody, or the tempo. It is also adding changes to flower accents, and other harmonies, adding or removing vibrato, and adding and removing timbres. The description should only be done after completing the basic work on the piece of music.

The best way is to start by studying the music. Pay attention to the lyrics, the rest will come in the process of practicing and gaining experience. You have to understand what is being sung and try to express the emotions and feelings of the lyrics to the audience. Looking at yourself in the mirror, the small emotions appearing in your eyes will help you increase the emotional power of the song.

The role of the teacher in the method

Renovating the teaching perspective to promote the positivity of students: Teaching in a suggestive way, creating opportunities for students to self-study and self-creative based on a system of theories of professional knowledge; use an effective combination of teaching methods and suggestive methods, teaching means, teaching aids; Innovating the process in the classroom is also a form of teaching method innovation that promotes the activeness of students.

Diverse forms of classroom organization: Teachers work directly with each student in technical training, song editing, etc. Two teachers work with one student when implementing the content of editing and matching, many teachers work. With 01 students in the lesson, there are instructors, experts, interpreters, accompanists, etc. In addition, the form of organizing classes in combination with music and groups is a way for students to access diverse subject content. more, the lesson will be more lively... For each content, there will be an appropriate form of organization and PP selection...

Improving the learning environment: The ideal learning environment in professional vocal teaching must ensure the following factors: adequate facilities, amenities, and a friendly and open interactive relationship between teachers and students. SV.

Effective use of teaching media: Teachers need to have knowledge and understanding of the voice, know how to influence each part appropriately, and use the correct function. Improving the hand of the piano helps teachers to play fluently with vocal patterns from easy to difficult, from slow to fast, from short to long, from simple to complex, and capable of displaying melodies of vocal works. , singing accompaniment for students... Effectively use other teaching aids such as radios, televisions, computers, sample music CDs, accompaniment CDs, sample singing CDs...

- To create excitement for students in learning and develop creative potential, it is necessary to keep a close relationship between Teacher and Student.

In addition to studying in the lecture hall during technical lessons, practicing practical skills is very important because if you only study in class. What teachers do not know, but students do not have an environment to practice practical skills, creativity and career development of students will be limited. Therefore, the teacher will help students practice practical skills through studying at the concert hall, they will be trained in performance skills with forms such as singing with the orchestra, learning choreography, listening to and watching typical works, performances of the world, and the country, and more importantly, participate in performances right at the faculty, at the school and perform at other schools. a major program of the Province.

Conclusion

Light Music Style is always a new way of expressing music. To have good and professional performances, singers need to train themselves to have a strong and confident musical ability, but to be able to perform well, we need a lot of different factors, including the following: The important factor is to have a teacher who has experience in teaching light music and to recruit students with real musical talent.
